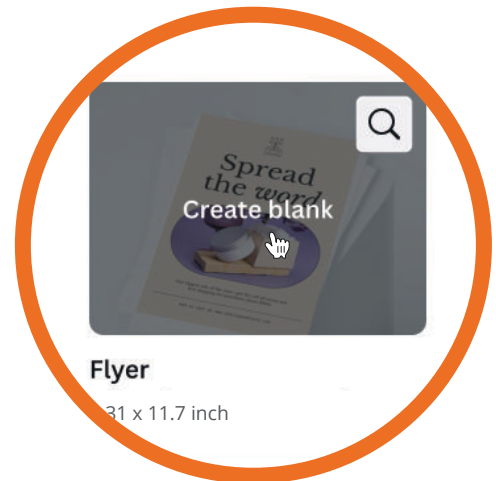

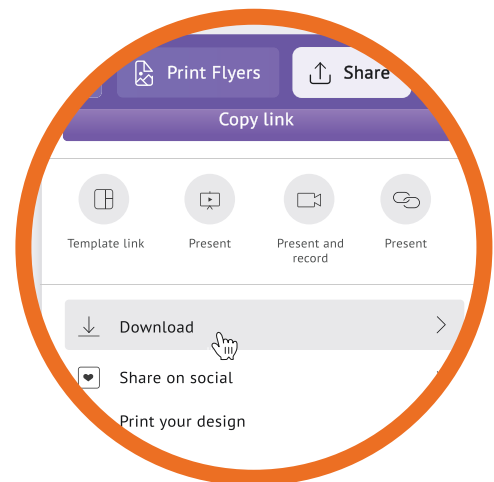
How To Download Designs In Canva As PDF For Printing

*Above the editor, click **Share**, and select **Download**.*



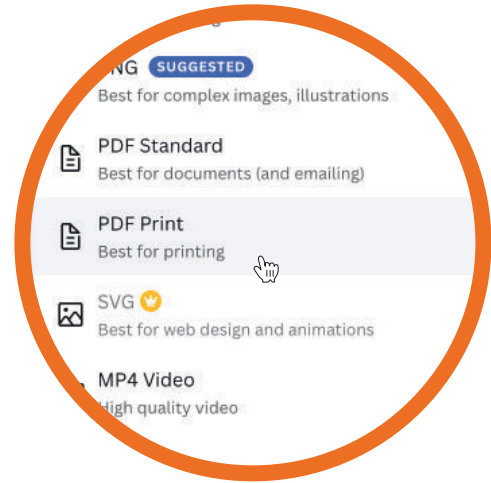

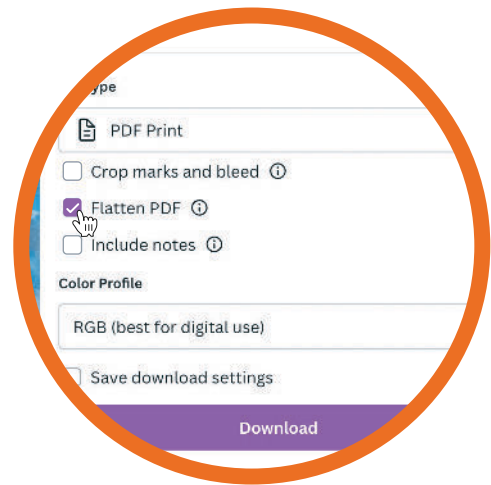




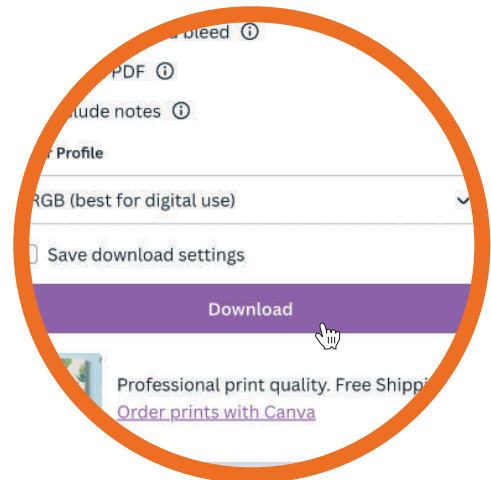
Select PDF print from the dropdown.
