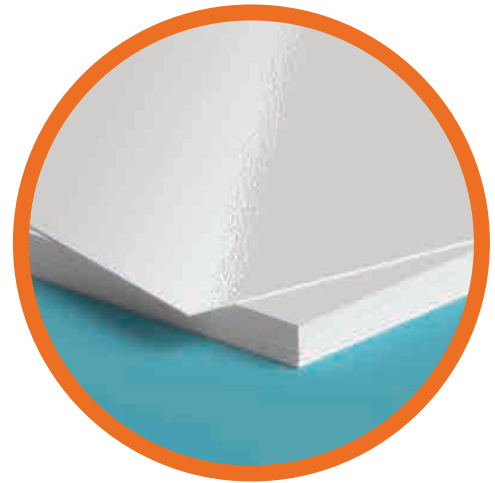

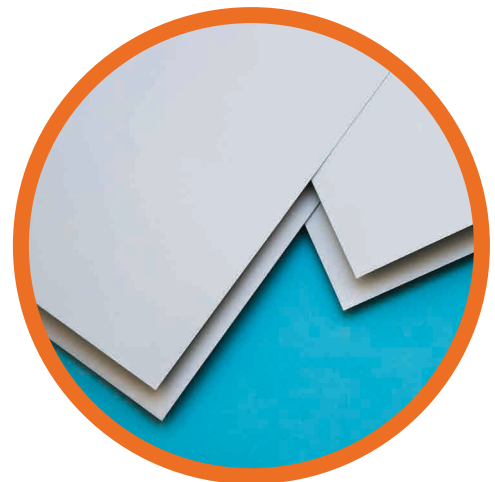
Coated paper has a smooth, glossy, or matte finish added to the paper's surface. It's used for high-quality printing, such as magazines, catalogs, and photography prints.
